

BRINDLE CUCKOO WALKS

Saturday, 24th April 2010

The Brindle Cuckoo Walks is a social occasion, staged for us to enjoy the delightful countryside round the village of Brindle and to raise funds to enhance and improve the new Community Hall. Entrants will be provided with route sheets well before the event and will receive a certificate on completion. There are four routes to choose from 6, 9, 12 and 24 miles long, all starting and finishing at the Community Hall in Water Street, Brindle.

- VENUE:** Brindle Community Hall, Water Street, Brindle, Chorley, PR6 8NH. GR 600243
- TIME:** 24 mile route..... Registration 0730 to 0750 hrs Walk starts at 0800 hrs
6, 9, and 12 mile routes..... Registration 0900 to 0950 hrs Walks start at 1000 hrs
- EQUIPMENT:** Entrants are expected to carry a map, compass, whistle and a first aid kit. The conditions are likely to be wet underfoot and stout footwear is recommended. All entrants should carry or wear waterproof clothing. Carrying food and water is worthwhile doing on the longer walks.
- REFRESHMENTS:** Tea or coffee will be available free of charge before the start of each event.
A meal with tea, coffee or cordial will be provided free of charge for all participants at the finish of their walk.
There will be hot and cold drinks at around the half way stage of the 6, 9 and 12 mile walks.
There will be no refreshments or checkpoints provided for the 24 mile walk. Entrants are expected to be self-sufficient and comply with any request from the walk leader.
- RETIREMENTS:** Any retirements must be at refreshment stops and the refreshment stop organiser notified of your intention.
An emergency telephone number will be available for use on the day.
A Risk Assessment has been completed and will be displayed in the Community Hall.
- RULES:**
1. Entrants must comply with the instructions of the organisers.
 2. All participants must keep to the prescribed route.
 3. All participants must abide by the Country Code.
 4. Family participants must walk together and retire together.
 5. Sorry – NO DOGS.
 6. The organisers and owners of the land used on the walks cannot be held responsible for any injury, loss, or damage caused or sustained by participants during the walk.
 7. All entrants under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a fee paying adult.
- ENTRY FEES:** Under 11 - Free Under 16 - £5-00 Over 16 - £6-50
Family (2 adults and children aged between 11 & 16) - £20-00
Entries on the day - £12-00 each. Apply for entry before 09.15 hrs.
- ENTRIES:** Entries close on Tuesday 21st April 2010
No entries on the day for the 24 mile route.
